Reach Out and Read Model

Pediatric healthcare providers are trained in the three-part Reach Out and Read model to promote early literacy and school readiness:

- In the exam room, doctors and nurses speak with parents about the importance of reading aloud to their young children every day, and offer age-appropriate tips and encouragement.
- The pediatric primary care provider gives every child 6 months through 5 years old a new, developmentally-appropriate children's book to take home and keep.
- In the waiting room, displays, information, and gently-used books create a literacy-rich environment. Where possible, volunteer readers read to the children, modeling for parents the pleasures and techniques of reading aloud.

Adopt-a-Site Program

Each donation of \$50 provides one child a new age-appropriate book at each well-visit from age 6 months to 5 years. Each child adopted through this program will receive a new book at every check-up to help build a home library. All donations will stay in your local area at your chosen Reach Out and Read program.

Reading Corners

For an additional \$500 you can provide a beautiful reading corner in the waiting room of a clinic in your community. Reading corners normally include an alphabet rug, literacy posters, a bookshelf, gently used books and a kid-size table and chairs. A literacy-rich experience is encouraged throughout the entire doctor's visit when children experience books right in the waiting room.
